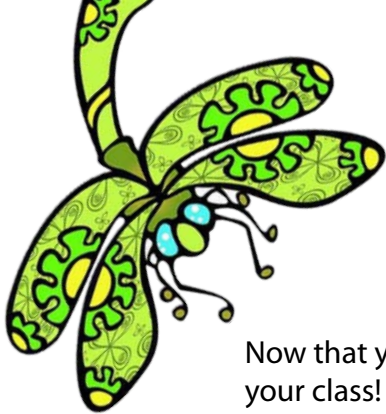

Note: Selection is subject to approval by WildBC and must be completed by the end of this school year. Deadline: First week of June. Allow 2 weeks to process.

Option 1 Up to \$200 toward Outdoor Field Trip of your choice

Criteria for field trips:

- Must be outdoors
- Must have a physically active component
- Must relate to your Science in Action theme

Covers:

- All or portion of **bus cost**, receipt required
- All or portion of **student program cost** at field site, receipt required

Doesn't cover:

- Materials
- Programs not associated with SIA or linked to SIA goals

Claim:

- School or school district submits invoice with copy of bus or program receipt to WildBC for reimbursement. Allow 6 weeks to process.

If you have remaining support time, your facilitator may be able to assist in field trip planning.

Option 2 5 hours of Outdoor Support by WildBC Facilitator

Criteria for Additional Facilitator Support:

- Must be outdoors
- Must have a physically active component
- Must relate to your Science in Action theme

Covers:

- Additional Facilitator time only (based on availability)
- Facilitator led field time for: guided walks, interpretation outdoors, activities or outdoor action projects that are extensions of or linked to SIA
